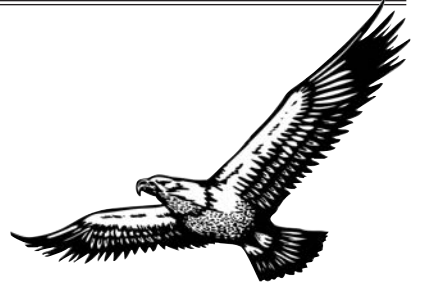

The 2014 Cross Country season came to an end on October 23 at the District meet. The meet was at Ottumwa Wildwood Park, hosted by Pekin. The boys Cross Country team consists of freshman Turner Klein and Logan Sieren, sophomore Jason Ree, juniors Ryan Chalupa and Dylan Burgdorf, and senior Grant Hill. Sieren finished first for the Keota team, coming in at 23rd place with a time of 17:05. Klein came in next at 38th with a time of 17:46. Ree, Burgdorf, and Hill came in 93rd, 94th, and 95th respectively, with times of 20:48, 20:55, and 21:04. Chalupa finished things off for the boys with a time of 22:44, placing 104th. The girls' squad had two runners: junior Mariah Lyle and senior Sierra Lyle. Mariah placed 74th with her time of 20:57, and Sierra came in 91st, earning a time of 22:49. Ree commented, "This was a great meet for everyone. Everyone gave their best effort and some had their personal records." Sieren said, "It was a great way to end the season. The seniors all did well and we are sad to see them go. They have shown great leadership this year, and I think they set us up for great years to come." Senior Bree Reed said, "It's been a great experience being a part of this small team; it felt like a family." "This was my best meet of the season, and probably career," Hill remarked. "Sierra and I went out there and gave it our all, knowing that this would be our last Cross Country meet ever." Sierra Lyle said, "It's been fun being a part of the cross country family. It's been nice being able to run with my sister and having my mother coach us." The team is coached by Angela Lyle.

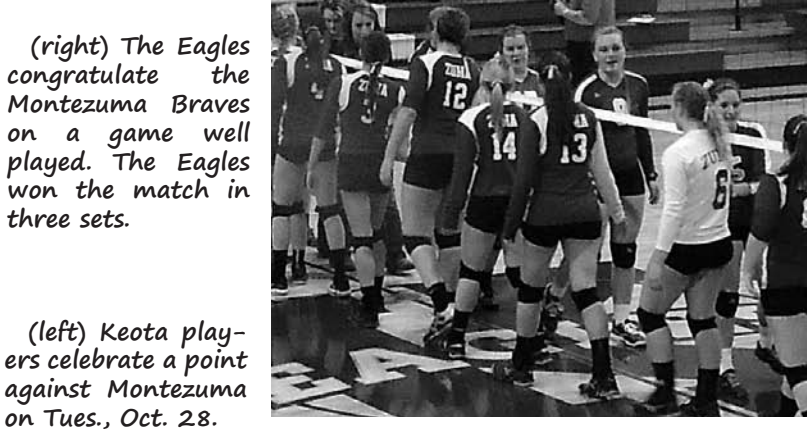

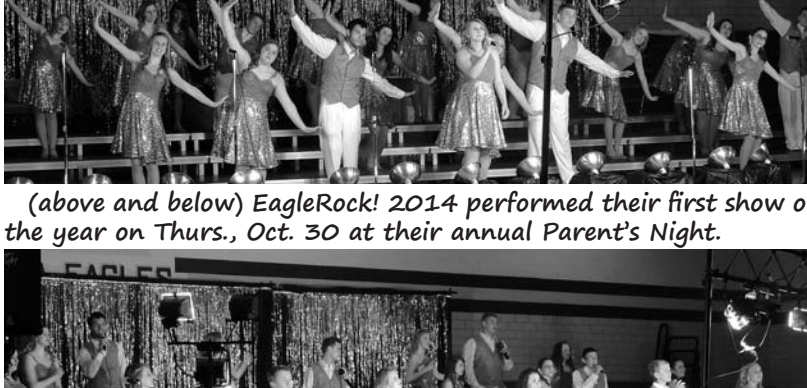

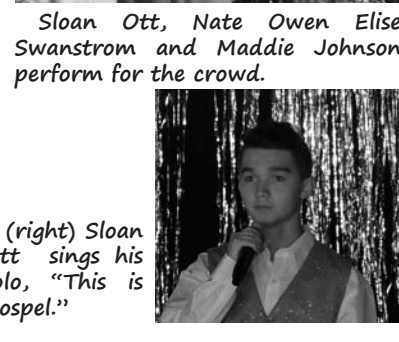
