A reminder to parents of children in the Keota Community School District – If you have not yet returned school registration papers for your child(ren), please do so to the school district no later than August 1st.

For incoming 7<sup>th</sup> graders (or any new student in gr. 8-12 to the district), there will be **7<sup>th</sup> Grade Orientation on Tuesday, August 22 at 3:00 PM.** Parents are welcome to attend, but it is not required. The 7<sup>th</sup> graders may bring in their school supplies and tour the building.

**“Back to School Night”** will be **Tuesday, August 22 from 5:30-6:30 PM** for all Keota Community School District students. Students may bring in their school supplies on this night.

**The first day of school for the Keota Community School District is Wednesday, August 23, 2017.** Jr.-Sr. High classes begin promptly @ 8:15 AM with school dismissing at 3:15 PM (unless noted different on the school calendar).

We will again this year continue with the GRADES 7-12 “Homework Intervention Program” that will run after school from 3:16-3:45 PM Monday through Thursday (except on early out days). The “Homework Intervention Program” is explained in more detail in the Parent-Student Handbook.
