If Trey had the opportunity to travel anywhere it would be to

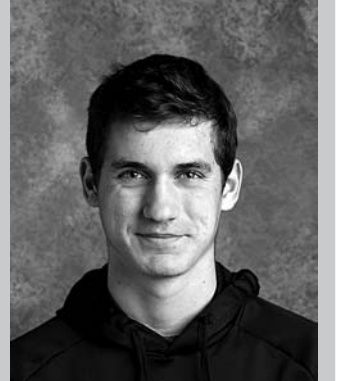
