Dear Keota Community School Patron,

When the 2021-22 school year ends, so will free meals for every student. While the federal government funded a program that allowed all students access to free meals during the COVID-19 pandemic, Congress recently declined to continue funding this program. This means all families will need to carry a positive balance in their children's school meal accounts when school begins in August 2022.

We understand this change may cause you to worry. There are important steps you can take to make sure your student receives the meals they need next year.

1. Complete an Application for Free and Reduced Meals – If your student qualifies for free or reduced meals, they can still receive them next year, but you must take action to make it happen. An application for school year 2022-23 will be included in school registration packets or can be picked up earlier at Keota CSD Central Office. Applications can NOT be processed before July 1, 2022 per the State of Iowa.

There is a 30 day grace period beginning the first day of school August 25th if you **already** qualified in **2021-22** for free meals through the application process. That 30 day period expires on **October 6<sup>th</sup> 2022**. If you do NOT fill out an application for free and reduced meals, your status will automatically be changed from free/reduced to full price, effective October 7<sup>th</sup>.

- 2. Budget for the Cost of School Lunches (if you do not qualify for free and reduced meals),
  Families that do not qualify for free or reduced meals can start depositing money into their students school lunch
  account to prepare for the cost of school lunches next year. Information on meal prices for the 2022-23 school year will
  be available in the near future.
- 3. Pay off Negative School Lunch Balances

If your student has a negative lunch account balance, we encourage you to pay that **by the end of the 2022 school year** and then begin depositing money into your student's account to prepare for the 2022-23 school year.
